The role of the Peak Railway Association is to support Peak Rail Ltd. by raising funds for specific projects, recruiting new members and volunteers, and helping to operate the existing railway from Matlock to Rowsley. The Association is managed by its own Board of Directors, who are elected by the members at an Annual General Meeting where every member is entitled to attend and vote and raise any questions they may have. Members unable to attend in person are able to appoint a proxy to attend and vote or speak on their behalf. Members are also able to become volunteers on the railway.

The subscriptions and donations received from members are used to finance the activities of the Association and fund specific projects around the railway. Items previously funded include the refurbishment of the ex Bamford signal box and its relocation to Rowsley. Repainting and reupholstering of carriages, new digital telephone exchanges at Darley Dale and Rowsley, sleepers for the main line, track components for Darley Dale level crossing, a building for the storage of the archive collection and the restoration of an LMS Brakevan. The association has also purchased the Cowans & Sheldon 35 ton steam breakdown crane from Peak Rail Ltd and is preparing to fund its restoration. More recently we have funded two way radios used for the revised method of operating into Matlock station and the provision of toilets in the car park at Rowsley. The funds for the toilets was raised by the 2022 annual raffle. Projects currently being funded are the improved locomotive watering facilities at Rowsley.
